




senter James May captured more than he bargained for on a recent filming of James May: Our Man in Italy, which was released July 14.

THE HOLLOW EARTH THEORY & THE SHAVER MYSTERIES

This collision of literary minds from a bygone era combined Shaver's pseudoscience with Palmer's entrepreneurial mysticism. Together, they promoted the possibility of alien beings dwelling in subterranean caverns and outer space.

Ray Palmer was only seven years old when a violent accident shattered his spine. His growth was stunted after an unsuccessful operation. He would suffer a lifetime of health-related issues as a deformed hunchback who stood about four feet tall.

Although he lived a reclusive, almost paranoid existence, Palmer found refuge in fantasy. He embraced the world of 1930's science fiction – worlds created not of hard science and fact, but imagination and possibility. Palmer inhabited the world of pulp fiction. It was an era before man walked on the moon, before thousands of spy satellites cluttered the skies, and before Kenneth Arnold saw nine flying discs flying above Mount Rainier.

Amazing Stories

In 1938, Ziff-Davis Publishing acquired the American science-fiction magazine *Amazing Stories* and recruited Palmer to become the editor. Palmer deserved the job, having already proven his mettle through *The Comet*, the first science fiction fanzine, and later *Fantasy Magazine*.

From Berwick, PA, Richard Sharpe Shaver wrote a series of controversial letters to *Amazing Stories*. Shaver claimed to have discovered an underground civilization populated by an advanced alien race, called The Elder Race or Titans. While working as a welder in a car factory, Shaver overheard the rantings of mentally deranged robots, named Deros – degenerate descendants of The Elder race. Their voices were transmitted through his welding gun.

Shaver learned that the Deros kidnapped and sexually

in several cities.

tortured humans and ate the flesh of others. Shaver also revealed that he had been imprisoned and tortured by the Deros and, what he called, their "damnable rays."

Although Shaver's narrative was dismissed and ing the regio thrown into the waste can by an editor, it was retrieved by Palmer, always looking for the next sensational headline. Palmer published the letters as "The Shaver Mysteries" even more fa between 1945 and 1948 and strongly implied that the "The Sh stories were authentic and possible accounts of an ancient subterranean civilization. Even as it was unique for the Shave Mystery Club

Even as it was unique for the period, Shaver borrowed heavily from H. G. Wells' *Time Machine* and H. P. Lovecraft's *Cthulhu* mythos. Other

themes by Edgar Rice Burroughs, Jules Verne, and John Cleves Symmes, recognized as the most famous of the early Hollow Earth theory advocates, were apparent. Shaver's contributions resonated between confirmation and debate.

As the controversy continued for decades, some questioned if Shaver's tale was science fiction or science fact. Many believed him. Shaver always asserted that his story was true, although the location of the entrance to this underground world of Titans and Deros was never revealed.

Although exciting and provocative, Shaver's account

went unsubstantiated. The Hollow Earth theory was popular in pre-science times before geologists determined that Earth's core contained a mass of scorching magma, rendering the region uninhabitable by any subterranean civilizations. The sci-fi tag team of Richard Sharpe Shaver and Raymond Palmer had created a fantastic story attracting an even more fantastic cult following that hungered for more.

"The Shaver Mystery" became a national phenomenon, providing a positive distraction for a war-weary

> public. After Palmer received thousands of letters from people claiming to have also heard the Dero voices, Shaver Mystery Club societies were organized in several cities. Readership of *Amaz*-

ing Stories increased in monthly circulation from about 135,000 to 185,000.

Ypsilanti State Hospital

Palmer and Shaver's relationship intersected between delusion and crass exploitation. To that end, Palmer was more adept at self-promotion than in maintaining his friend's confidentiality. Palmer publicly revealed that Shaver was mentally ill. He said that Shaver spent eight years, not in the Cavern World as a prisoner of the Deros, but in a mental ward at Michigan's Ypsilanti State HAUNTED ENTERTAINMENT



Hospital. While there, Shaver was treated for an undetermined psychosis, most likely paranoid schizophrenia.

Shaver responded to Palmer's expose, adhering to his bizarre story about the hollow earth. He also addressed the accusations about his mental health:

My problems, I realized, did not stem from cognitive impairment. I wasn't crazy in the traditional sense, even though, at times, I felt like I was being driven mad by the hateful rays that were being beamed at me by the people below. No, I was sane in an insane world.

I have always wondered how many people, who have been institutionalized because they were diagnosed as crazy, were, in fact, victims, such as myself, of the damnable rays. Did they think that they were insane because of the voices they heard in their heads and voluntarily committed themselves? Even today, I wonder if most mental illness forms are not insidious attacks from the world below.

In any case, Richard Sharpe Shaver demonstrated classic symptoms of paranoid schizophrenia, but although he was mentally ill, he was also somewhat of a genius. Richard Toronto's book, *War Over Lemuria*, documented that other literary geniuses, including poet William Blake, scientist Galileo, and sci-fi writer Philip K. Dick, suffered from psychosis.

Still, Shaver's delusions were implausibly accepted by many who claimed to have heard the Dero's voices. Shaver gave birth to the modern-day version of the Hollow Earth theory and added to the fabric of Coal Region mythology, thematically linked to the Sheppton mining disaster, where trapped miners reported seeing humanoid creatures underground, as well as a vision of Pope John XXIII, who had died two months earlier.

Even stranger was what Palmer and Shaver contributed to the annals of ufology. In a 1947 FBI Office memorandum titled "Flying discs, Richard Shaver," the FBI concluded that Palmer and Shaver conspired to create the "flying disc" hysteria" gripping the nation. They said, "It is possible, therefore, that the entire flying disc theory was created by Palmer and Shaver."

Shaver died in 1975. He spent his final years in Arkansas, where he was known as an artist who had discovered "rock books," which he believed were the recorded history of The Elder Race. He is buried in the Layton Cemetery in Yellville, Arkansas. ◆

MCINVILLE PARANORMAL Donna Gerron: From Experiencer to Investigator

ode enforcement officer Donna Gerron began experiencing paranormal phenomenon when she was 11 years old. She was visiting her aunt in Topeka, Kansas, when she realized the house was haunted.

Donna witnessed bedroom lights going on and off by themselves, heard unexplainable banging noises, and was even touched by unseen hands. Instead of being scared of these experiences, Donna was both surprised and intrigued. While these occurrences piqued her interest in the unexplained, she didn't begin paranormal research until after her mother passed away, when she began experiencing paranormal events.

Today, Donna is the team manager of McInville Paranormal, based out of Phoenix, AZ. She recently talked to *Paranormal Underground* magazine about her paranormal experiences, investigative techniques, paranormal equipment, and her favorite cases.

* * * * *

Q: Please tell us a little about yourself, both personally and professionally.

Donna: I was born and raised in Chicago. One of 13 children from a blended family. I lived in Central Illinois for 25 years and moved to Arizona five years ago to be closer to some of my family.

I am a mother of five. My children are Andre, who's 38, my 30-year-old daughter Arriana, 29-year-old twin boys LeRoy and LaRon, and nine-year-old daughter Crystal. My little one is my biological granddaughter. I adopted her when she was three, because Arriana has intellectual disabilities and could not take care of her. Crystal is autistic and non-verbal. It's a challenge at times, but they are worth it.



Donna Gerron, team manager of McInville Paranormal, first encountered the paranormal as a pre-teen. After repeated unexplained experiences over the years, Donna took her paranormal research to the next level and began investigating with others.



The McInville Paranormal team, based out of Phoenix, AZ, investigates all aspects of the paranormal, including hauntings, cryptids, UFOs, and mysticism.

I am a Code Enforcement Officer with Maricopa County in Arizona and the team manager for McInville Paranormal Arizona Division.

Q: When was McInville Paranormal founded?

Donna: The original team was founded in 2009. The team has gone through two rebranding phases, the first was with three co-founders. Then after two co-founders

left, the team was rebranded in July 2022 as McInville Paranormal, which is named after its current founder Eldon McInville.

Eldon is also from the Chicago area who now resides in Southern Arizona. He moved there from Glendale, Ari-

zona, and put his trust in me to run the Arizona team.

Q: Who else is on the team?

Donna: Our team includes founder Eldon McInville, administrator Erica Goseyun, case manager Stacey Pritchett, lead investigator Stacy Gust, lead researcher Anna Gerron, tech manager Charles Lamb, psychic mediums Michael Ann Gilipin and Tiffany Reynolds, and mystic Bradley Powers.

Other members include technician Trevor Lee Grams and investigators Shari Burris, Charley Gust, Kenny Garcia, Karyn Caryl, and Lou Zola.

Q: Talk about your team's overall mission.

Donna: We want to investigate all aspects of the paranormal, not just spirits, but also cryptids, UFOs, and mysticism. We want to help people and find the truth.

Q: How did you become interested in the paranormal and joining a paranormal investigative team?

Donna: I had experiences when I was younger that made

"I heard unexplainable knocks and footsteps." The TV would go on and off by itself." me want to see what was out there. I used to go on ghost tours back in Illinois, and after my mother died, I starting having a lot of experiences.

This group basically found me. I was scrolling on Facebook one day and saw a post from Erica Goseyun about them

looking for investigators. I responded, I met with her and Eldon, and the rest is history. I never thought I'd be a part of a paranormal team, let alone managing one, but I went from an investigator to team manager in just a few months.

Q: Tell us about your personal paranormal experiences.

Donna: In addition to paranormal experiences at my aunt's house, I lived in an apartment in Harvey, IL, where my mother saw a full-body apparition of a woman in the hall. I never saw her but felt her presence on more than one occasion.

After my mother passed away in 2005, I would feel the bed move as if someone sat on it, heard knocks at the door and on my bedroom window, and heard footsteps on a carpeted floor. The TV would also go on or off by itself.

Q: What interests you most about the paranormal?

Donna: What interests me the most is the unknown and trying to find answers as to why certain things happen or why some spirits are still earthbound.

Q: What different types of locations has your team investigated?

Donna: We have investigated private residences, cemeteries, historical sites, historical buildings, abandoned ghost towns, mining towns, commercial buildings, and battlefields.

We investigated a residence for a gentleman who was having trouble with items being thrown, being moved, and shadow figures in his home. We didn't catch anything on camera, because mysteriously my camera malfunctioned during the investigation.

We did get activity on the K-II Meter, and the Cat Balls. Our medium and lead investigator cleansed the house, and the homeowner hasn't had any activity since. We've also investigated old TB hospitals, old jails, trailers where murders had taken place, and cemeteries.

Q: What equipment do you usually take with you on an investigation?

Donna: I especially like my digital recorders. I have a ghost box that was built for me that scans the radio frequencies but without the white noise. The EVPs come through a lot clearer. I also use **REM-PODs**, and a camcorder. I love using the Cat Balls.

Q: What methodologies do you use during investigations?

Donna: We work through the process of eliminating natural causes for things that are happening. Say that the reason that something moved was the wind, that an orb wasn't from an exterior light source, or that the noises that were heard wasn't a car, animal, or other outside noises.

Q: What is the most important part of a paranormal investigation?

Donna: Maintaining respect for our clients, their property, the public, each other and the spirits at all times. We are not aggressive in our approach, and we don't try to antagonize spirits into interacting.

Q: What cases will you remember the most and why?

Donna: As of right now, the Gleeson Jail and surround-

ing areas in Gleeson, Arizona. I got some very good EVPs and hits on the REM-POD. One EVP was of a male voice that said, "You're amazing." When I said, "What was that?" a male voice replied, "Yeah."

I also caught an EVP a couple of weeks ago in a cemetery. I put out a Cat Ball and caught a little girl's voice that said, "Cat." And I have another EVP where a little girl says, "Milkshake."

Since I'm relatively new at this, I'm still waiting on that "Oh shit" moment when I capture something really big.

Q: Talk about common misconceptions about the paranormal field that you've encountered.

Donna: There are those who believe that everything that happens is evil or that it's a demon. Not all spirits are bad and out to hurt people.

Q: Whose work in the paranormal field do you respect the most and why?

Donna: I respect Eldon McInville our founder. He's very knowledgeable and has taught me a lot, and I still have a lot to learn. He has about 20 years combining studies and research with infield experience.

Q: What locations do you have on your wish list to investigate?

Donna: I would love to go to Gettysburg, Pearl Harbor, and Alcatraz.

Q: Any upcoming projects you'd like to share?

Donna: We're doing some local investigations at the moment. We are looking to go to St. Albans Sanatorium in Fairlawn, VA, in May 2023.

Q: What words of wisdom would you offer beginner paranormal investigators?

Donna: Be patient. Spirits don't cooperate on command. And investigating the paranormal is not always exciting. Going through evidence can be tedious.

You may sit in front of the computer or monitor for an hour and not see anything. Other days you'll get a ton of evidence.

Q: What else should our readers know about you and your team?

Donna: We are a new team, and they are a great group of individuals. We work together as if we've been a team for years. We are working hard to hone our skills and to do great things one day.

Also, at McInville Paranormal and Pee Dee Region Paranormal LLC, we call ourselves Para-Fam, which means Paranormal Family. There is Para-Tek Laboratories, Para-Fam Studios, Para-Fam Entertainment, and DV TV. We just welcomed Dedrick Hilton into the Para-Fam network; he is the founder of Hoo Doo Lounge, Hoo Doo Lounge TV, and the Hoo Doo Lounge Paranormal News Network.

I also co-host a podcast, called *Paranormal Hotseat*, where we interview people in the paranormal field and have paranormal discussions. It's on Sunday nights at 7 PM mountain time.

Q&A WITH ELDON MCINVILLE SR., Founder of McInville Paranormal

Q: Tell us about yourself.

Eldon: I am a retired over-the-road truck driver, and I'm a paranormal investigator. I started actively investigating around 2009. However, I did several years of study on the subject prior to actively investigating. My studies and investigation in the field involve about 20 years of work and learning so far.

Q: Tell us about McInville Paranormal.

Eldon: McInville Paranormal is a team that I am taking to a global level of presence. My first team I developed was called Arizona Paranormal Research & Investigations. Being it was my first team, learning as I went, things were touch and go and slow-moving for us. We would practice in local spots, such as cemeteries and the occasional historic building here and there when the opportunity would arise.

A few years later, I came into contact with another team founder that had his team out of state. After some in-depth conversations, we soon realized that our visions for growth, expansion, and ethics were very much the same. We decided to combine our teams and rebrand it all under one name. But, we didn't stop there. We bought a third team owner in and rebranded as Global United Paranormal Foundation.

Our vision for this new organization was really simple: help as many people that are afflicted and tormented by paranormal activity as we can, in all forms of the paranormal, including hauntings, UFO and alien sightings, and cryptid sightings, including, Mothman, Jersey Devil, Skinwalkers, etc. We built a network of many other teams and organizations over the next several months. Among these organizations was one in particular that was very significant to me: Pee Dee Region Paranormal. Not only were they colleagues in the field, but I also was able to determine they were my actual blood relatives that I'd never met. Yes, a newly discovered family connected through the paranormal field. Who would have ever thought about it. I certainly didn't expect it, but what a wonderful find.

Not long after, one of the co-founders of Global United decided to depart and venture off on his own, which we supported, because this is a field with so many different ideas and thought processes. Soon after his departure, Global United and Pee Dee Region Paranormal came up with a shortened name for what we were calling ourselves: ParaFam, meaning the Paranormal Family.

Q: What can you tell us about the ParaFam concept?

Eldon: Our concept for ParaFam has often been compared to a term in the paranormal field known as ParaUnity. But the two are very much different in so many ways.

With ParaFam, as the name indicates, family is the key. And

family doesn't necessarily mean brother, sister, uncle, father, etc. It means we are there for each other, during paranormal aspects and in our personal lives. We are there for each other on and off the field. We check in with each other, we make sure everyone in the family is OK, we support one another, and as with many other real-life families, we safeguard each other from outside negative influences. It's for this reason, we have few organizations within our ParaFam Inner Circle. We all need to trust one another. This is where the concept of ParaFam Entertainment was born.

Q: What is ParaFam Entertainment?

Eldon: We air podcasts, and we let others stream from our platform and to our social media sites. We went a step further and have developed a channel on ROKU TV. Currently, it is the ParaFam Entertainment channel. ParaFam Entertainment has been developed into a broadcasting company. The company has a few subsets of businesses under it, one being ParaFam Studios.

In our Studios division, we develop show intros and credit outros, logos, thumbnail banners, and even commercials. We use this division as support for those especially broadcasting through ParaFam Entertainment, but it is a service available to everyone. The neat aspect to ParaFam Entertainment and Studios is that it complements all genres. And as long as it's rated PG and family friendly, it can broadcast on ParaFam Entertainment.

At this point, the other cofounder of Global United had decided to step out of the field, leaving the organization to me. Not feeling right about continuing on with the name Global United Paranormal Foundation, which was a combined concept between three co-founders, I decided to once again rebrand the organization to McInville Paranormal. The ideas and visions remained the same.

The other organizations that are among the ParaFam Inner Circle are McInville Paranormal, PeeDee Region Paranormal LLC, First Line Paranormal, Paranormal Brew, Whispering Angels, Get Haunted Network, DN-TV UK, and HooDoo Lounge Paranormal. Others are also in the Inner Circle, such as alien abductee Jim Andre, mystic Bradley Powers, PeeDee Region Paranormal LLC Ohio Division, and Paranormal Postmortem UK. We also have a couple other divisions within our organizations: Para-Tek Laboratories and Stellar Paranormal Events.

Para-Tek Laboratories focuses on the development of new equipment. Stellar Paranormal Events brings the community together for worldwide events, as well as broadcasting them so they can support the historic locations they investigate. Between McInville Paranormal and PeeDee Region Paranormal LLC, we are steering ParaFam into a complete support system for the paranormal field, emphasizing the legitimacy of the field. \blacklozenge

INTELLIGENT HAUNTINGS VS. DIMENSIONAL HAUNTINGS What's the Difference?

A ve you ever walked into a haunted location and felt something watching you or had a sense that you awakened something from its slumber? This is actually a pretty common feeling among many researchers exploring different paranormal haunts and otherworldly hangouts.

But is it the actual researcher who decides what kind of experience they will have? Do we slowly coalesce our fears with the haunted? And what is the difference between intelligent and dimensional hauntings?

Fear does factor in more than most people want to admit when they go to various locations, especially those that are notoriously active. If I know a location is haunted, my first rule of thumb is to find my zen place and stay there throughout the investigation. I get comfortable within myself so that my reaction to things can be more on the rational end of the spectrum instead of emotionally freaking out.

There's a scream ready to come out in all of us, so with that being said, just remember to stay calm. It's important to conciliate our reactions so we don't alert other things hiding in the darkness.

Intelligence is key to both intelligent and dimensional hauntings. But to me, that's the only commonality the two have. As humans, we play a part in the indelible regeneration of intelligent hauntings. But with dimensional hauntings, it's obvious that we aren't needed in the mix of things. Other beings enter the picture here, and they can create a dichotomy that doesn't involve the human spectacle.

Intelligent Hauntings

Intelligent hauntings seem to come in various packages, so to speak, because the history of the location plays



a major part in the activity. This includes what humans have done in the past, where the haunting is located, and the surrounding topography.

Add in the various shades of scary, and each haunting can be polar opposite from each other yet eerily similar. This is the oxymoron of the paranormal. In a sense, the inscribed tangled web that we weave as humans echoes and stays alive in the creepypasta nostalgia of recorded time. It imprints on its own destiny.

The Spirit to Human Connection

How is your relationship with the dead? As a researcher, it's important to understand that communication changes into another realm. So, we have to listen differently, more so within our souls. Whispers, cold spots, the wisp of a slight wind swirling past you, or disembodied voices all indicate the departed human yearning to convey their unspoken desires.

As in life, we love to be invited into our friends' homes, so how can it be any different when we eventually depart this life? An invitation is an invitation after all, but what we invite into our homes can become the squatting spirit or defiling entity that constantly reminds us that we did, after all, invite them in.

Ouija boards give a carte blanche message to those unearthly beings just waiting for the unsuspecting human's invitation. There is intelligence in something that waits for the invitation. The question one must ask is: Why must they be invited in? The darkness always seems to play by a freakishly perverse rule book that is just always out of reach for mere mortals.

Intelligent hauntings where spirits reside happen for a multitude of reasons. Tragic deaths, slow and painful deaths, or the shock and awe of an unintended death seem to create the conditions for the inadvertent haunting. Attachments can come from such tragedies because the dearly departed hold onto the humanism of who they once were.

The vessel, "our body," becomes a casualty of death, and if death is sudden, how can a soul come to grips with the loss of their identity as a human? This loss, I feel, is the greatest travesty for those who have passed on quickly and unsuspectingly. It seems plausible they would attach to a location or human who seems familiar.

The Peeping Tom

We can include in this category ghostly observant, spying eyes, those that glow without a body but with a slight outline of a face. Pareidolia can be a mean trick of the eyes, but then movement happens and we see a darkness blacker than black scuttle past us.



This Peeping-Tom entity, who is invited into unsuspecting human homes, somehow, some way, devours human emotions. We are the energy sustenance for these creatures, and while they thrive, we are depleted of our reservoirs of light and energy. When visible cracks show up, such as emotional and physical stress, fatigue, or family problems, it's easy to lose our connection to source and try to sustain our lives on a weak link.

These dark entities know this because the best place for these kinds of creepy intruders is in a home of unrest. All they have to do is sit back and feast.

Do we console the despairing spirit with an understanding and then command the unwelcome entity to leave? Finding absolution for spirits is crucial, along with giving them a finality that otherwise eludes them. If not, situations can escalate to a critical point of foreboding for the living and an eternal suffering for the dead.

As for uninviting an entity that thinks they can live in a person's home, that's a different matter altogether. If people take fear out of the equation and remember they have divine resonance on this planet, there would be fewer problems with these dark and shadowy squatters. A

commanding self-confident demeanor pointing toward the door can make the difference. A rebuke even for them can be uncomfortable, especially when they know the game is up.

Dimensional Hauntings

Dimensional hauntings mix the high strangeness of paranormal phenomena with an out-of-this-world brew that doesn't need any humans to spice it up. Skinwalker Ranch southeast of Ballard, Utah; the Bradshaw Ranch in Sedona, Arizona; and the Stardust Ranch in Buckeye, Arizona, have many things in common, but the most important is the supposed portals on each of these ranches.

Witnesses have spotted strange orbs, Sasquatch footprints and sightings, UFOs zipping in and out of view, human-looking aliens, and flickers of light that can only be seen through the lens of a camera. These things happen on a daily basis on all of the ranches.

Whether we witness all of these phenomena or not, it goes on with or without us. Multiple people can witness different types of the paranormal at these locations, sometimes at the same time. And mind you, I just mentioned three ranches.

My partner Michael and I have some of these phenomena happening around our home. Our Douglas Fir trees in our front yard form a slight curve, and they serve perfectly as a portal for our Fae folk and other entities that come through from time to time.

Portal Intelligence

With large portals, the difference between them and the small ones in front of our house is the fact that spacecraft, as well as military jets, helicopters, and other aerial phenomena, fly through the large portals, disappearing into nothingness ... or so it seems.

We can't obviously see what's on the other side. But I think something more happens beyond the ordinary. John Edmonds, the owner of Stardust Ranch in Arizona, had an experience where an intelligence seemed to hear him speaking to his realtor on the day he was moving onto his ranch.

He arrived to find no furniture had been removed by the prior owners. Everything was still there. Obviously, John was upset and wanted everything out so he could move his things in. Long story short, when he came back hours later that day, the former owner's things that were in the house were seemingly haphazardly thrown into a swimming pool that was by the house.

The kicker here is that John doesn't know if the realtor got a hold of the former owners; it was assumed he didn't. So, who put the furniture and things into the pool — which was full of water by the way.

Who was listening in? Could it have been one of the many entities, aliens, humanoid beings, light beings seen around the ranch? To this day, John and his wife still experience paranormal phenomena, and it has even affected their animals. This is another disconcerting aspect of the dimensional hauntings, animals seem to get sick or mutilated. Why this happens is an unknown question that eludes researchers and experiencers to this day.

Topography

The topography may be a key to understanding portals, because what is underground or around the portal

could be affecting how they actually work. Granite, limestone, iron, or copper deposits from old mines can actually help to battery up the portals from this side. If so, it would make sense where some of these large portals are located.

There can be many elements that come into play, and that can also include underground aquifers. Think about the power of a waterfall and the immense energy that can be felt from the water falling into a pool of water at high speed. Could these not be portals as well?

Energy or a high frequency can charge up around portals, large or small. Is there a link between our side of the portal and where it connects on the other side? Does the other side of the portal know about us on this side?

The bottom line is that there is an intelligence behind all of it. How did the intelligence get there? Maybe we just need to understand that the paranormal isn't outside of us, but it's inside of us – because sometimes it seems the answers are just a heartbeat away.

We All Affect the Paranormal

The paranormal changes with us, and I truly believe we affect it. Each of us has the ability to become a piece to the puzzle of haunted disclosure. If we know how much a

> part we play in the matrix of this reality, the dimensional and intelligent hauntings very well could be the exit points.

With dimensional hauntings, we could continually skirt the outer limits of what is known versus what is unknown.

And with intelligent hauntings, there could be the bond with our familiar humanness, along with those abrupt endings and the never-ending display of emotional despair, angst, or wrath. Maybe we could finally understand we are more than just our bodies.

Morpheus from *The Matrix* said, "What you know you can't explain, but you feel it. You've felt it your entire life." Maybe intelligent and dimensional hauntings are the reminders that there's more to us than we know. All we have to do is start to remember who we are so that the haunted become peaceful and portals become doorways of forgotten truths remembered. ◆

HAUNTED WOLFSEGG CASTLE THE LADY IN WHITE

rom 1974 to 1976, I was stationed in Nürnberg, Germany, at the Merrell Barracks. I worked as an undercover military policeman in Germany with the U.S. military's Drug Suppression Team and Criminal Investigation Division.

Working undercover, I was sent all over Germany. I also took advantage of military discounted trips, and one place I visited and was very fond of was the isolated village of Wolfsegg. Overlooking this village is a mighty fortress named the Wolfsegg Castle.

I became aware of several stories in regard to a countess named Klara von Helfenstein, who was married to Ulrich von Laaber, a knight of noble birth. One story has Klara sleeping around with military troops that took lodge at the castle. Apparently, Klara Photo: <u>25x25.eu</u>

didn't get enough attention from her husband, because he was always on the road for his military travels.

Ulrich built the beautiful castle in 1028 to protect the village and give his wife a beautiful home. Even though the castle was very beautiful from the outside, there was violence inside. There were stories of murders behind the castle walls, and one of those stories is of a love triangle that went South.

Apparently, Klara was set up by her own family to have an affair with a military man that took lodging at the castle. Why? They wanted to take ownership of the castle after Klara's adulterous relationship was discovered.

But things went terribly wrong, and when Ulrich found out, he killed Klara and her lover in a fit of

rage. Klara's family, in a moment of retribution, then killed Ulrich.

The Lady in White

Legend has it that Klara now haunts the castle. She's called the Wolfsegg Castle Lady in White, because she's seen wearing white robes while she constantly walks the halls and stairways.

Tourists feel cold spots or they will have a cold gust of wind hit them, and they believe this is Klara. Some tourists have seen glowing orbs move about in the castle. Skeptics believe that the glowing orbs are merely will-o'-the-wisps that originate from bat-filled caverns.

When I visited this castle, I was with my military buddy, Wayne, at the time. While Wayne was exploring one section of the castle, he heard a woman whisper in his ear and say, "Du bist hübsch," which basically means "you are cute" in English.

When he heard this voice, he felt a hand on his back side. Wayne was somewhat of a jokester, so it was very hard for me to believe his story, but as long as I knew Wayne, he insisted the story was true. \blacklozenge

REVISITING THE

n August 28, 1995, Fox TV broadcast the "alien autopsy film" for the first time. It was a 17-minute black-and-white film supposedly depicting a secret medical examination and autopsy of an alien by the U.S. military.

The program, hosted in the U.S. by Jonathan Frakes, was titled *Alien Autopsy: Fact or Fiction*. The film was broadcast by Channel 4 in the U.K. as a segment of *The Roswell Incident*. London-based entrepreneur Ray Santilli presented it as an authentic autopsy on the body of an alien recovered from the 1947 crash of a flying disc near Roswell, New Mexico. The film footage was allegedly supplied to him by a retired military cameraman who wished to remain anonymous.

Experts, including pathologist Cyril Wecht, special effects specialist Stan Winston, and cinematographer Allen Daviau, are shown commenting on the film's authenticity. The program caused a sensation, with *Time* magazine declaring that the film had sparked a debate "with an intensity not lavished on any home movie since the Zapruder film."

Fox rebroadcasted the program twice, each time to higher ratings. But even after segment director John Jopson told producer Robert Kiviat that he suspects the entire film is a fake, Fox made it clear that such suspicions would not be allowed.

Mike Maloney, a former photographer for the London tabloid *Daily Mirror*, said it was the same footage that he saw in the late 1970s at a private viewing in the Los Angeles house of a Disney executive. In 2006, Santilli admitted that the film was not authentic, but rather a staged reconstruction of footage (using sheep brains and jelly stuffed into puppets made by U.K. sculptor John




Humphreys) that he claimed to have viewed in 1992 but which had deteriorated and become unusable by the time he made his film.

The military cameraman was portrayed by a homeless man in Los Angeles. Santilli claimed that a few frames from the original were embedded in his film, but he never specified which ones.

Producer Spyros Melaris claimed that he had made all the auxiliary footage, including that of the homeless man. The existence of an original filmstrip of the alleged autopsy has never been independently verified.

In my book *Roswell Alien Autopsy* — *The Truth Behind the Film That Shocked the World*, I detail the entire story, from the genesis of the idea to fake such a film to all of the facts that prove the film is 100% fake. ◆

wiches, six of the blue flowers transformed into six tiny people. And two of the tiny people jumped on their picnic blanket, stole some cherries, and ran off.

Mila says that the six gnomes had silly-looking outfits on that were blue in color and two of the gnomes were wearing pointed hats. Ida says this forest is infested with little people, and they were fortunate to actually have an encounter with them.


Mila and Ida said they were not afraid at all and thought the little people looked cute. \blacklozenge

The hardest people to help are skeptics who will not accept spirit entities are real.

I come from a psychic family and trained for some years to be a spirit medium as spirits always spoke to me. But wiser heads than I said I was too well protected and should become an exorcist. But doing so is not for everyone. You have to live a special kind of life, and never going into pubs or becoming close to anyone of low caliber. You have to be a vegetarian and have no part in the killing industries. Avoiding most people is part of the course.

For three days before an exorcism, you must pray meditate and fast. The Black Fast, as it's called, means your stomach must be empty. The film of the alien bursting from a man's stomach is an exaggerated illustration of evil spirits taking hold of the putrefied food in the gut.

The body and clothing must also be clean, and your thoughts for the preceding three days should also be as pure as possible. As a top Catholic exorcist Dom Robert Petitpierre advised, I invoke the four archangels for assistance.

Called Out to Do an Exorcism

My call-out was just a stone's throw from the magnificent Leeds Cathedral. Exorcisms now are no longer the province of the Church, as many will only minister to regular churchgoers and many priests no longer have the skills.

For this exorcism, however, I had been informed that a young boy was being tormented at night and strange liquid was oozing through the wall of his bedroom, accompanied by strange scratching sounds. The boy's parents



said he would no longer sleep in his room and instead chose to sleep in the conservatory.

Upon examination, an explanation was apparent. I took the family outside to a broken gutter, where rain had been spilling down the wall. And when it rained, it would come through and stain the wall paper; the mysterious oozing was just rain reacting to the wallpaper paste. The scratching was the house cat wanting to be let in.

It was all slowly explained away, but it did appear to me that the parents both worked long hours, so I suggested they both spend more time with their son.

On the long train journey home, I felt such deep relief, as a battle with some elemental spirit from the lower realms was the last thing any sane person would ever want.

I have learned at my own expense, though, to prepare properly for an exorcism. I once had three call-outs in a row that were just people's imagination. So, I had not prepared well for the fourth legitimate call-out. Unfortunately, I became mentally disturbed and desperately ill for some time after the exorcism. But that's a story for another day. \blacklozenge



STRANGE HAPPENINGS IN ELVERTA

In February, we arrived to investigate a home with a very troubled past in Elverta, California. According to the homeowner, Willie, the home was the site of a murder/suicide by the previous owners.

Unknown voices are heard in the home. An entity with a long black robe and hoodie is seen. While they also have a friendly ghost they call Wilber, they also believe there are negative entities present. Extreme evil and negativity is felt in the house.

Willie did mention that one of the neighbors was a witch, and he though the house may be cursed. So he asked us to conduct an investigation and cleansing.

HPI investigators present were myself; Deanna Jaxine Stinson, psychic medium; Alaceo "Big Al" Rosatano, EVP technician; Mike Ouilhon, EMF sweeper; Ryan Privee, equipment specialist; and investigators Debra Skold, Robert Christopher Castaneda, Leanne Shriver Leighty, Ava Foreman, and Kim Foreman.

The Investigation

The home to be investigated was beautiful and spacious, and the decor was over-the-top. Willie's backyard is the size of a neighborhood park, with a swimming pool. There was a lot to explore.

We had two investigative sessions that were an hour each, with briefings after each investigation. During the briefings, we shared evidence captured with Willie.

Mike and Ryan obtained vulgar messages through their spirit boxes, and Ryan even got a message about Satan. The messages were obscene, so I will not go into detail. Deanna saw an entity in front of the house that went over to a neighboring house. Since it was at a neighbor's house, I did not want to go on their property, so I stood in the middle of the street and captured a crystal-clear recording of a man saying, "Just for a second."

Deanna also saw the spirit of a little girl with long hair in the house, and Willie said that they have indeed seen a little girl in the house. Deanna also picked up on an entity in the backyard, and I obtained an EVP of a man saying, "No," and with some hesitation, he said, "No" again.

Ryan saw a stick figure or shadow person in one of the rooms in the house.

I explained to the new investigators that if they take a picture of an orb, look for intelligent interaction. I demonstrated this by placing my hand in the air and telling the entity to appear by my hand; Debra then snapped a photo and an orb appeared by my hand. The entity listened to my command and appeared as an orb by my hand, showing intelligent interaction, something I can deem as paranormal.

If I can't show intelligent interaction, then the orb can be almost anything, including lint, skin flakes, dew drops, light refractions, dust, etc.

Robert took a picture of a strange light-blue object, but he was able to debunk it as a reflective lighting on




